

# PAWNEE HILLS MEN'S LEAGUE RULES

1. Only those holding golf memberships in good standing in the Pawnee Hills Country Club may compete in Men's League. League Dues are \$25 and must be paid before beginning play the 1<sup>st</sup> week.
  2. Current prize list: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$150, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$115, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$100, 4<sup>th</sup> - \$90, 5<sup>th</sup> - \$80, 6<sup>th</sup> - \$70, 7<sup>th</sup> - \$65, 8<sup>th</sup> - \$60, 9<sup>th</sup> - \$55, 10<sup>th</sup> - \$50. Total payout is \$835.
  3. All league matches must be played on the designated league day.
  4. Teams that do not finish their round will receive zero (0) points for that match unless **that entire league play** is called off due to unplayable or dangerous conditions. Teams may **NOT** agree to withdraw and split points. Early League and Late League are considered separate leagues as the weather conditions may change between Early League and Late League play.
  5. Handicap system is:
    - a. Use last ten (10) league scores, throw out worst two (2)
    - b. All handicaps each week will be adjusted by the computer using the USGA/GHIN equitable stroke method as shown:

**Players with a handicap of:**  
4 or less.....Double Bogey on any hole 5 to 9.....7 on any hole  
10 to 14.....8 on any hole  
15 to 18.....9 on any hole
    - c. Please write down your ACTUAL score for each hole on your scorecard.
    - d. Player's previous scores in the league will be brought in to figure his handicap. If a player has no previous scores in the league, his handicap will be established the first night of play using his score that night. The maximum handicap used for any player will be 18.
  6. Match Play format will be used to determine team points. There are 10 points to be won between the "A" players and 10 points to be won between the "B" players for a total of 20 team points. Points will be scored in the following manner:
    - a. The low handicap player of a team will play the low handicap player of the other team whether he is a substitute or a regular team member. The play will be a match play format with the handicap assessed on each applicable hole.

**Example:** Player A on team 1 has an 6 handicap and his opponent player A on team 2 has a 10 handicap. There are four strokes difference in handicap so player A on team 2 will get a stroke handicap on each of the four hardest handicap holes which would be on 2-7-1-and 6. Player B on team 1 has a 7 handicap and his opponent player B on team 2 has a 18 handicap. There are 11 strokes difference in handicap so player B on team 2 will get 2 strokes on the two hardest handicap holes, which would be 2 and 7 and 1 stroke on each of the other holes.There also will be 1 bonus point for the low net score between players. You get 1 point for winning the hole, 1/2 point for tying the hole, and 1 bonus point for the low net score (your 9 hole score minus your handicap). Points won for each match must always equal 10 points.

- a. When a **team** has a "bye" or is playing against a "ghost" (unopposed), you must play against a blind score card draw from your team's division.
  - b. If only one member or a substitute of a team plays, he will play both the A player and the B player of the other team for 20 points.
  - c. If only one member or a substitute of each team is present, they will play each other for 20 points.
  - d. If only one member or a substitute plays and there is a "no show" by the other team, that player will play against the "A" and "B" players from the blind score card draw from your team's division.
  - e. If there is not a player or sub representing either team in a match, both teams will receive zero (0) points.
8. A score shot when you are playing against a bye or "ghost" will be against a blind score card draw from your division and will be used in calculating your league handicap. When your opponents do not show up or your are against the "ghost" you or a substitute must play to get your points.
  9. Any league player can sub on either shift. His handicap for subbing will be the one established in his regular league.
  10. League members are allowed during play to move stakes, markers, signs, etc. in order to make a swing without moving the ball, provided the ball is in legal play.
  11. League members are allowed during play to ground their club in the hazard area on holes #5 and #6.
  12. In order to promote **FASTER PLAY**, league members are allowed lateral movement from the hazard area on holes #5 & #6 on lost tee shots and unplayable lies. Both teams should agree on approximate distance for lost balls. **1 stroke penalty.**
  13. We will use "winter rules" **in your own fairway.** You may not move the ball more than 6 inches from it's original lie.
  14. Score cards are to be turned in to the clubhouse immediately following play.
  15. A maximum of two (2) weather related postponements will be rescheduled at the end of the season.
